Remember, any student wearing tight or revealing clothing will be subject to disciplinary action.

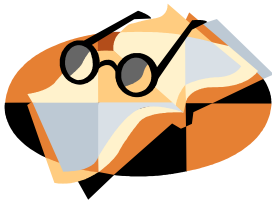
### Senior Baseball Jerseys

### *Action Steps for Parents to Protect Your Child and Family from the Flu this School Year*

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends 4 main ways you and your family may keep from getting sick with the flu at school and at home:

**1. Practice good hand hygiene**

by washing your hands often with soap and water, especially after coughing or sneezing. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective.

**2. Cover your mouth and nose**

with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. If you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your elbow or shoulder; not into your hands.

**3. Stay home if you or your child is sick**

for at least 24 hours after there is no longer a fever or signs of a fever (without the use of fever-reducing medicine). Keeping sick students at home means that they keep their viruses to themselves rather than sharing them with others.

**4. Get your family vaccinated**

for seasonal flu and 2009 H1N1 flu when vaccines are available.
